If you have an allergy or a religious requirement for meals, we will do our best to provide those needs for you. We invite you to bring foods that you are required to or are medically needed. We will provide storage in the dining hall for any special food requirements. Please talk to our dining hall staff about preparation.

Our Summer menu is approved by a dietitian for the use at camp.

We do not have the ability to support a special diet, or your specific food desires that are not medically or religious requirement based. Please make other arrangements as necessary.

Refunds or discounts are not possible based on food. Our price for camp is set because we can get the best price possible for food based on the 4800 meals we will be providing.

We follow Canton City School policies on peanut butter, and do not provide it in the Dining Hall. If your unit would like to have peanut butter in your campsite, you may bring it and request bread from the dining hall.
