# HOW TO REGISTER

Space is limited and first come first serve. To reserve your space, simply follow the steps below. **Please note, you need to register in TWO places to secure your spot.**

1. Go to <http://www.buckeyecouncil.org/Event.aspx?id=3535> to register with the Buckeye Council.
  - Click on "Register Now" in the top right hand corner of the event.
  - You have the option to pay in full, pay the deposit of \$175, or pay any amount greater than \$175.
2. Go to <http://www.summitbsa.org/events/jamboree/jamboree-registration/> to register with the National BSA.
  - You will need your My.Scouting username and password. If you do not have a My.Scouting account, go to [My.Scouting.org](http://My.Scouting.org) and follow the directions to create an account.
  - Click on "New Registrations Start Here" to begin the registration process.
  - After entering the required fields about the participant attending Jamboree, click Continue.
  - For Boy Scouts, Click on SCOUTING YOUTH PARTICIPANT Application. For Venturers, click on VENTURING YOUTH PARTICIPANT Application.
  - After agreeing to Terms and Conditions, you will be on the registration page.
  - Enter Unit Type and Unit Number.
    - Unit Type will either be Pack, Troop, or Crew.
    - Unit Number is your 4-digit Pack, Troop, or Crew number. Below are the district numbers in Buckeye Council. For example, if you are in Hetuck and in Troop 4, your 4-digit unit number is 1004. Or if you are in Killbuck District and in Troop 355, your 4-digit number is 4355.
      - Hetuck District = 1
      - Sandy Beaver District = 2
      - Killbuck District = 4
      - Netawotwes District = 5
      - Tuskegee District = 9
    - Council Name and Number: Buckeye Council 436
    - Fill out the rest of the application
