

Boy Scout Summer Camp Duty to God Program Requirements (for youth & adults)

1. Participants must complete the four requirements:
 - a. Attend a religious service at Camp.
 - b. Participate in at least three daily devotionals with your troop or appropriate group at Camp
 - c. Say grace before meals.*
 - d. The Troop Chaplain Aide and the Scout leader must promise to obtain and review the “Duty to God” religious emblems brochure [No. 5-879] and make a presentation at a regular troop meeting. For more information visit:
